**ITEM 15**  

**METHOD OF CANCELING ITEMS**

 As this tariff is supplemented, numbered items with letter suffixes cancel correspondingly numbered items in the original tariff, or in a prior supplement. Letter suffixes will be used in alphabetical sequence starting with A. Example: Item 100-A cancels Item 100 and Item 300-B cancels Item 300-A in prior supplement, which, in turn, canceled Item 300.

**WEIGHING CHARGES**

 When cars are weighed or reweighed, loaded or empty, at request of consignor or consignee, a charge of \$73.00 per car will be assessed.

---

**ITEM 110**

**OVERLOADS**

 The charges in this section are published as a deterrent to the unsafe practice of overloading rail cars and are not connected in any way with other transportation charges. When a loaded car is weighed and the gross weight (commodity plus tare weight) exceeds the maximum gross weight as determined by the car's capacity by 5,000 pounds or more, (See Note) car shall be considered "overloaded" and an overload charge will be assessed delivering Carrier on inbound and CW Customer on outbound as stated below in addition to the intra-plant switch charge set for in CW Tariff 8894-series Item 150. Railroad scale weights shall govern.

| **ITEM 120**   [I]  **FURNISHED EQUIPMENT USED FOR OFFLINE MOVEMENTS**   Colorado and Wyoming Railway Co (CW) will assess a \$1337.00 per car charge against shippers or carriers routing CW owned, leased or controlled equipment via routes that exclude CW from participation in the route and/or line haul revenue. This charge is an addition to any other charges which may be due from shipper or carrier.   Exception 1: With prior permission from the Colorado & Wyoming Railway Co. (719) 561-6358, a shipper or carrier can utilize such equipment, without penalty, for outbound shipment via a carrier other than CW.
